OECD- STRING seminar in Gothenburg November 17 2020

The OECD and STRING are conducting a Swedish national seminar on how Northern Europe can become a green Silicon Valley- an internationally competitive green megaregion, producing, developing, testing and championing green technologies and sustainable infrastructure.

Participants will get the opportunity to provide their input and set the direction for the coming strategic report that the cooperation between the OECD and STRING will result in. The report will contain concrete political recommendations for the entire STRING area, stretching from Hamburg to Oslo.

- Mayor of the City of Gothenburg, Axel Josefson and Member of the Regional Executive Board for Region Västra Götaland, Kristina Jonäng, will open the OECD seminar.
- Former European Commissioner for Climate Action, Connie Hedegaard, will moderate the event.
- Head of the Urban Policies Review in the OECD Soo-Jin Kim will present the direction of the concrete policy recommendations for the ScanMed corridor Oslo-Gothenburg-Malmö-Copenhagen-Hamburg.
- President and CEO of AB Volvo, Marin Lundstedt, will talk about the importance of infrastructure connectivity for Swedish competitiveness.
- Other key actors will provide their perspectives
